Aurangzeb was a cruel human and our school books have praised him, whitewashed his brutality, turned him into a hero!

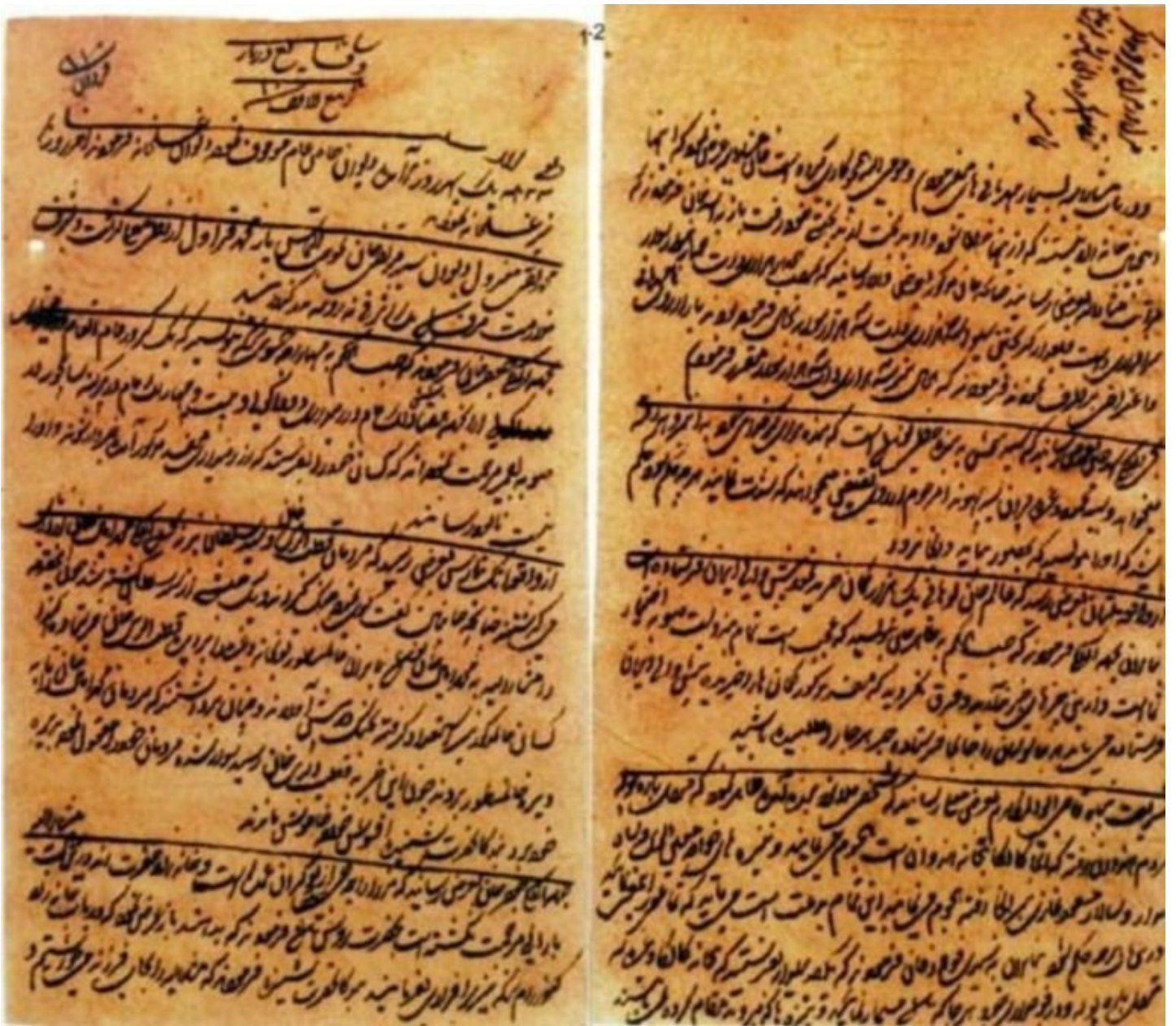
Let's read another story which shows the inhuman face of Aurangzeb!

This picture shows the Farman of Aurangzeb (3 September 1667) ordering destruction of Kalkaji temple in Delhi.
