Sources close to Gandhi told *rediff.com* that she has a number of meetings, both official and unofficial, in New York and in Washington.

They said she would focus on eliciting support from non-resident Indians for the revitalization process in the party.

"Sonia Gandhi wants the Congress party to reach out to people (of Indian origin) in different countries," the sources said.

The visit comes less than a month after Manmohan Singh was hosted by the Indian National Overseas Congress in New York. She had earlier spent a day in Iceland as a guest of that country's president.

On Monday, Gandhi will address a closed-door meeting organized jointly by the Asia Society and the Council of Foreign Relations followed by a meeting with former secretary of state Henry Kissinger.

In the evening, she will be attending a public reception hosted by the Indian National Overseas Congress at the Sheraton Hotel.

During her two-day sojourn in New York, Gandhi will also address the United Nations General Assembly and is expected to meet Secretary General Kofi Annan before traveling to Washington, DC, on the morning of June 27.

In Washington, she will address a meeting of Indian Americans and the congressional caucus on India on June 27.

Natwar Singh told *rediff.com* that Sonia Gandhi was expected to meet 'very important people'. But she will not have a meeting with President George Bush, he added.

The last time Gandhi visited New York was in 1993 in connection with a meeting of the Rajiv Gandhi Foundation.

the fuel power reflected the chaos in Delhi, as it moved on to the tarmac, stopped and seemed to be waiting for instructions.

After the plane flew off to Lahore - the next stop was Dubai and eventually Kandahar - Dulat maintains that the "CMG degenerated into a blame game...with the cabinet secretary being head of the CMG as one target and NSG chief Nikhil Kumar, another." A major indictment as the Crisis Management Team sat for five hours in the first instance, and clearly was unable to take any decision with sheer chaos reigning.

The decapitated body of a Norwegian kidnapped after Childs fled was dropped on a mountain path, and police recovered the body of a British hostage two years ago. None of the other captives was ever found.

Officials at New Delhi's Tihar jail say the FBI interviewed Azhar there in 1996.

On April 27, 1998, the U.S. Embassy asked permission for two FBI agents to interview Azhar again, along with three of his jailed supporters. Indian authorities said it appeared that the 1998 request was granted.

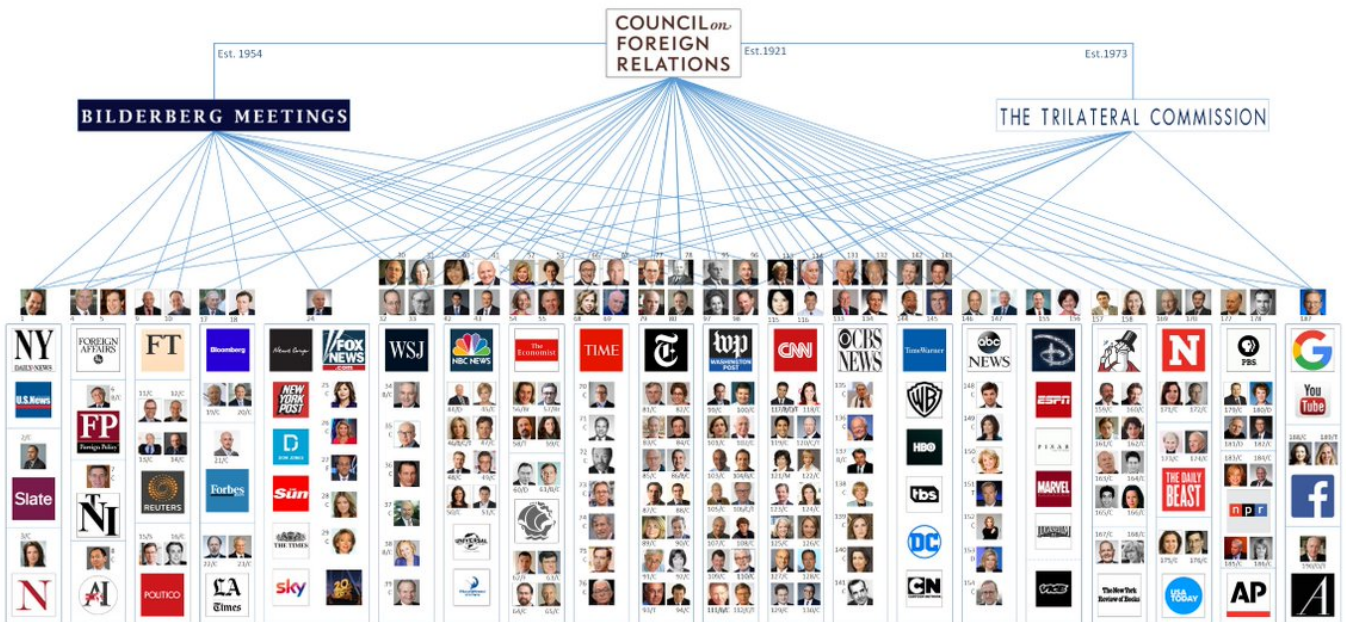

Unaware of this 'protocol', and finding it rather strange that senior leaders of the party refrained from even sitting on the same sofa as their president, I decided to take a seat across from Gandhi.
