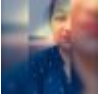

Mulabagilu is originated from the word 'Moodalabagilu' in Kannada which means eastern door. It is said to be the eastern gate of the Vijayanagara empire.

The Kshetra palaka Sri Anjaneya was installed by Pandava Arjuna.



After Mahabharata war, Arjun realised Hanuman's on the flag that was tied to his chariot in war. Later Arjuna went on a pilgrimage along with the Hanuman flag. On the way he installed the power of Hanuman on the flag in the murti in Mulbagal (also called Shathaka vatpuri).



The murti is made on granite and about 12 feet tall.

There is a Venkateswara murti believed to have been installed by Maharshi Vasishtha.

A lizard is carved on the wall and people take its blessings as it is believed that it would free them from ills of lizard falling on body.
