सुमित्रानंदन पंत (1900-1977)

20 मई 1900 को उत्तराखंड के कौसानी-अलमोड़ा में जन्मे सुमित्रानंदन पंत ने बचपन से ही कविता लिखना शुरू कर दिया था। सात साल की उम्र में स्कूल में काव्य पाठ के लिए पुरस्कृत हुए। 1915 में स्थायी रूप से साहित्य सृजन शुरू किया और छायावाद के प्रमुख स्तंभ के रूप में जाने गए।

पंत जी की आरंभिक कविताओं में प्रकृति प्रेम और रहस्यवाद झलकता है। इसके बाद वे मार्क्स और महात्मा गांधी के विचारों से प्रभावित हुए। इनकी बाद की कविताओं में अरविंद दर्शन का प्रभाव स्पष्ट नज़र आता है।

जीविका के क्षेत्र में पंत जी उदयशंकर संस्कृति केंद्र से जुड़े। आकाशवाणी के परामर्शदाता रहे। लोकायतन सांस्कृतिक संस्था की स्थापना की। 1961 में भारत सरकार ने इन्हें पद्मभूषण सम्मान से अलंकृत किया। हिंदी के पहले ज्ञानपीठ पुरस्कार विजेता हुए।

पंत जी को कला और बूढ़ा चाँद कविता संग्रह पर 1960 में साहित्य अकादेमी पुरस्कार, 1969 में चिदंबरा संग्रह पर ज्ञानपीठ पुरस्कार सहित अनेक पुरस्कारों से सम्मानित किया गया। उनका निधन 28 दिसंबर 1977 को हुआ।

इनकी अन्य प्रमुख कृतियाँ हैं—वीणा, पल्लव, युगवाणी, ग्राम्या, स्वर्णकिरण और लोकायतन।

Yuri fell in love with India and had to go underground in India and couldn't help Russia much. But he was handed over to Russia.

Despite this he managed to escape to Canada but was unfortunately killed there.
