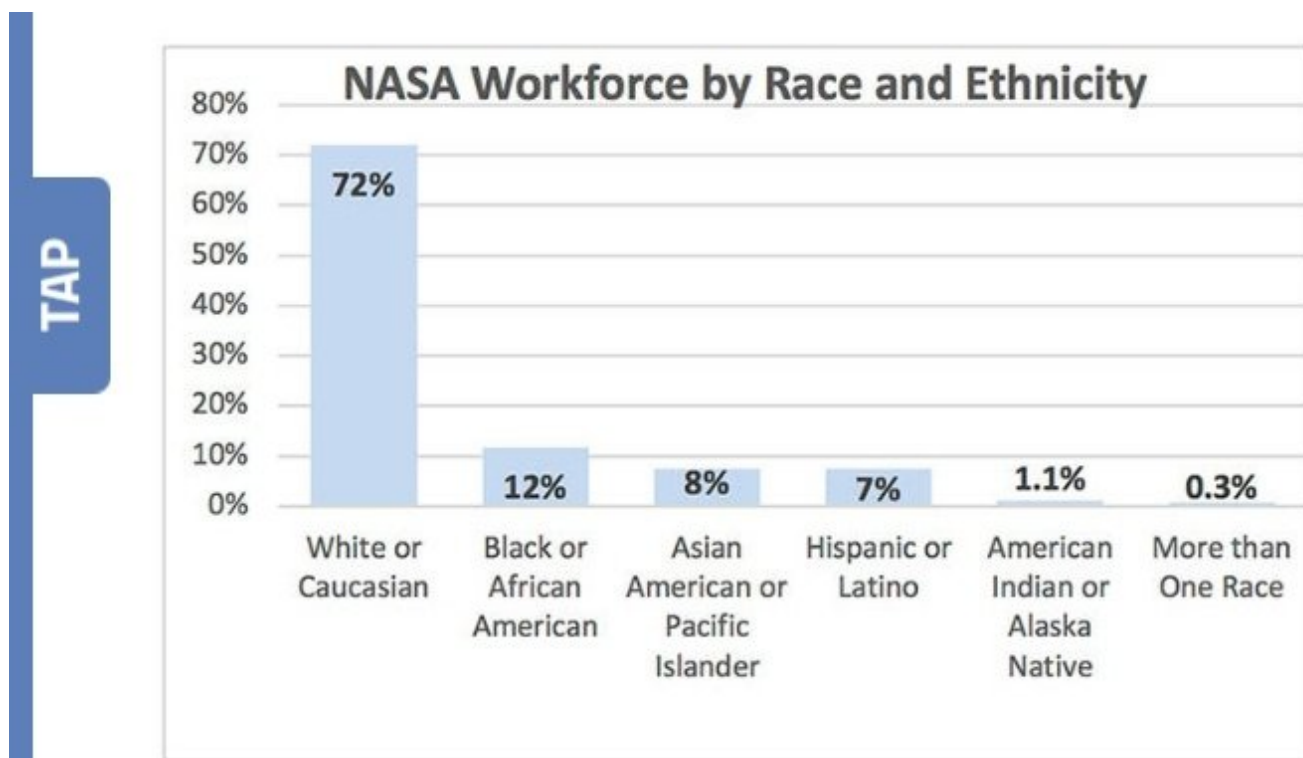


### Indian Americans at NASA
