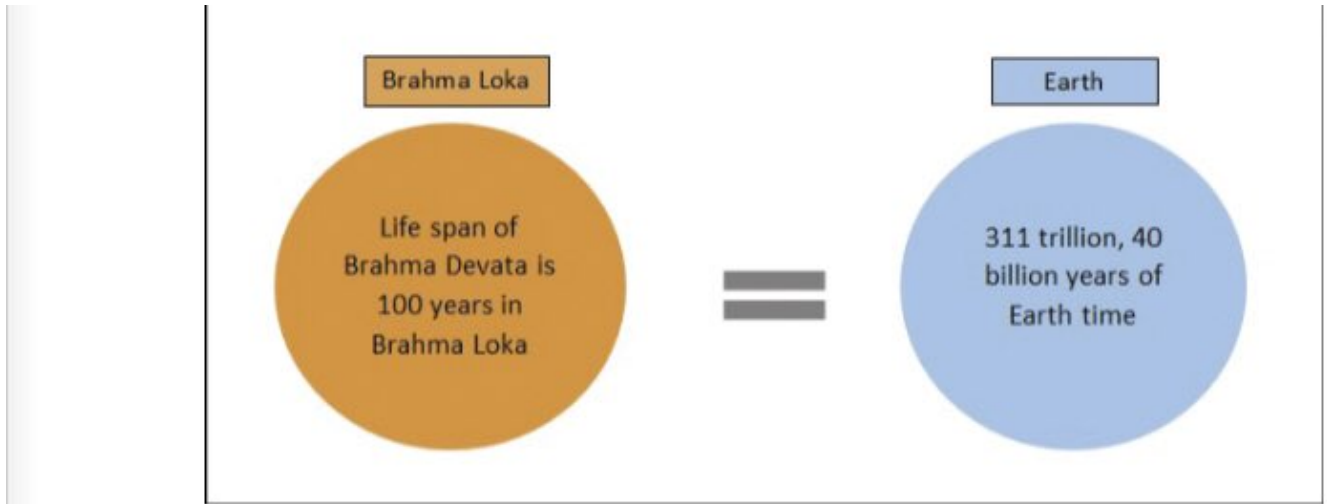

HOW OLD IS THE UNIVERSE

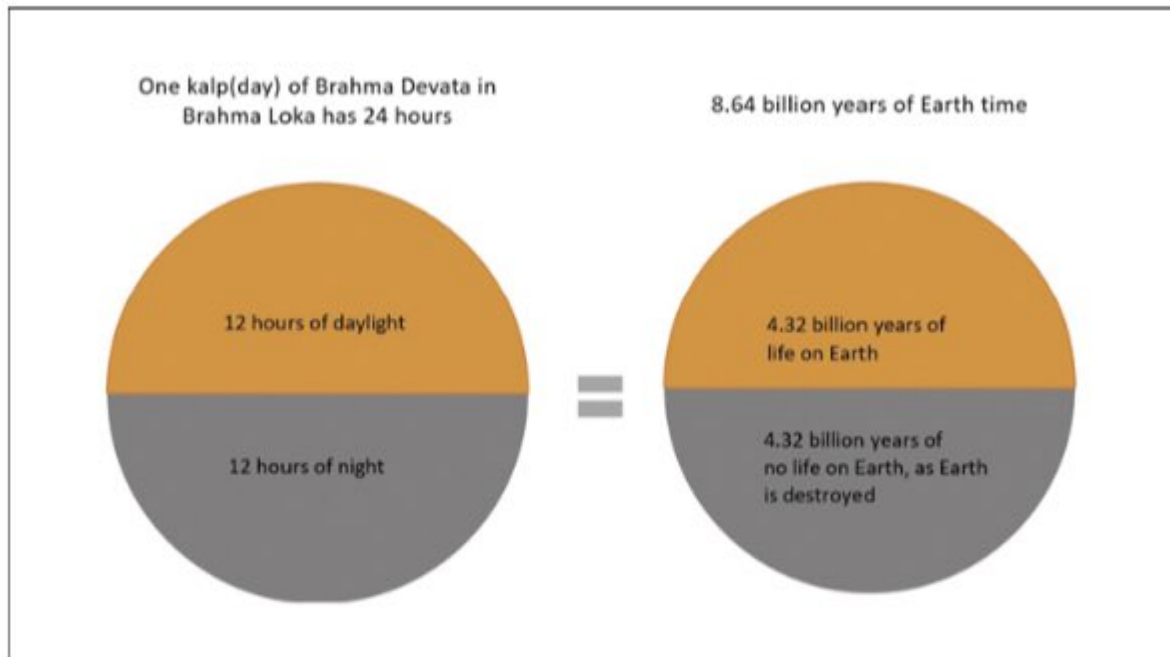

KALP IN BRAHMA LOKA

One kalp (day) of Brahma devata in Brahma loka is made up of 24 hours which includes 12 hours of daylight and 12 hours of night. The 12 hours of daylight in Brahma loka, is when creation takes place, as earth is created and life exists on earth .

What is the relationship between a *kalp* in *Brahma Loka* and time on Earth?



*12 hours of daylight in Brahma Loka = 4.32 billion years of life on Earth
(14 manvantar + 15 sandhya)*

*12 hours of night in Brahma Loka = 4.32 billion years of no life on Earth,
as Earth is destroyed*

Towards the end of the 12 hours of daylight in Brahma loka, pralaya begins with Bhagwan shiv on earth
Earth is created again at the start of the next kalp of 12 hours of daylight in Brahma loka which will once again followed by
pralaya during the 12 hours of night

This ongoing process creation preservation and destruction in our universe will continue for the lifespan of our Brahma
devata, which 100 years in Brahma loka time .
