This was very well guarded by a monkey called Dadhimukha. Dadhimukha was sitting in front of this garden at 4 doors. Only Sugriva was allowed in.

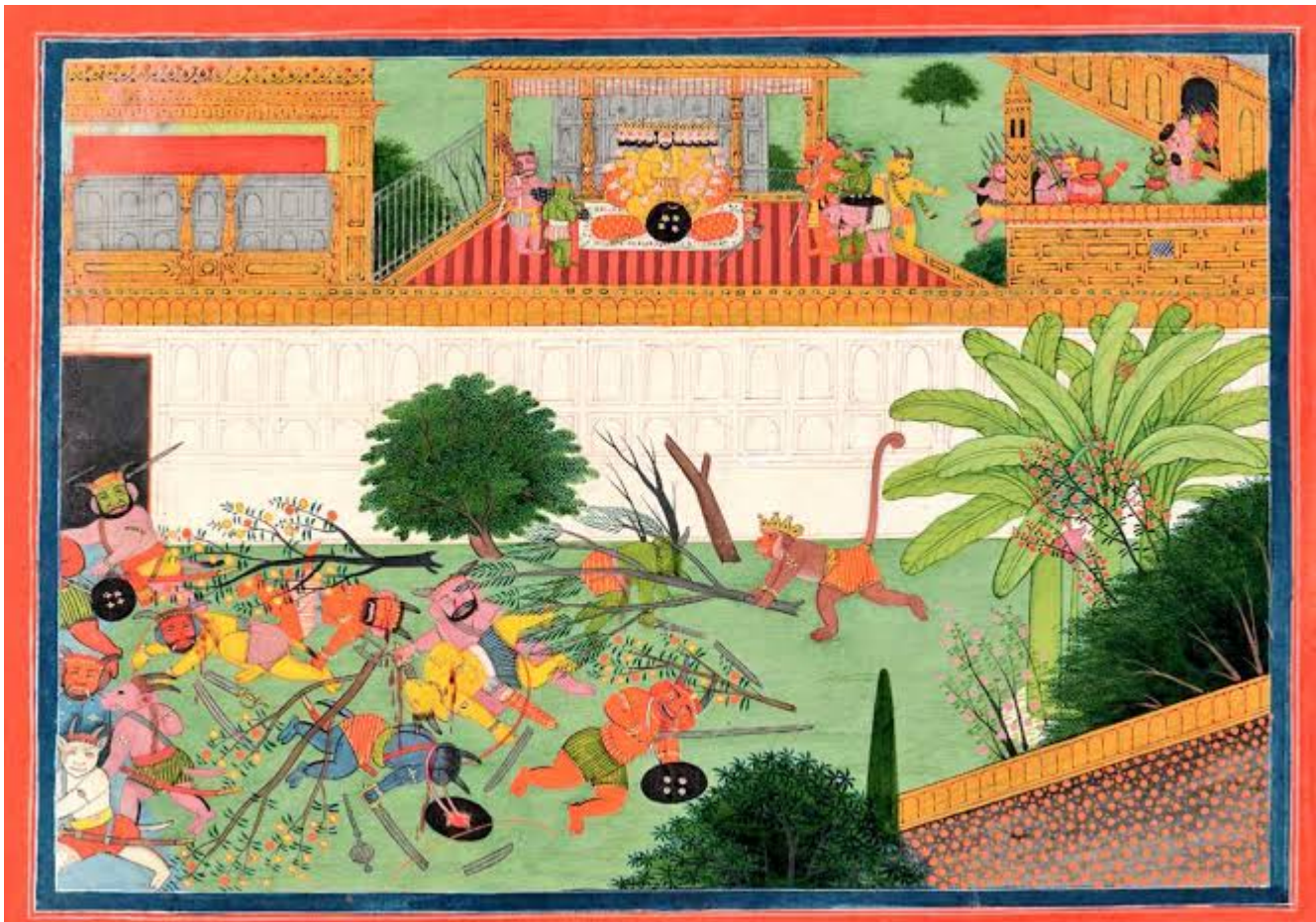
So the monkeys while returning, wanted some fun in Madhuvana and enjoy honey there. They expressed this to Hanuman.

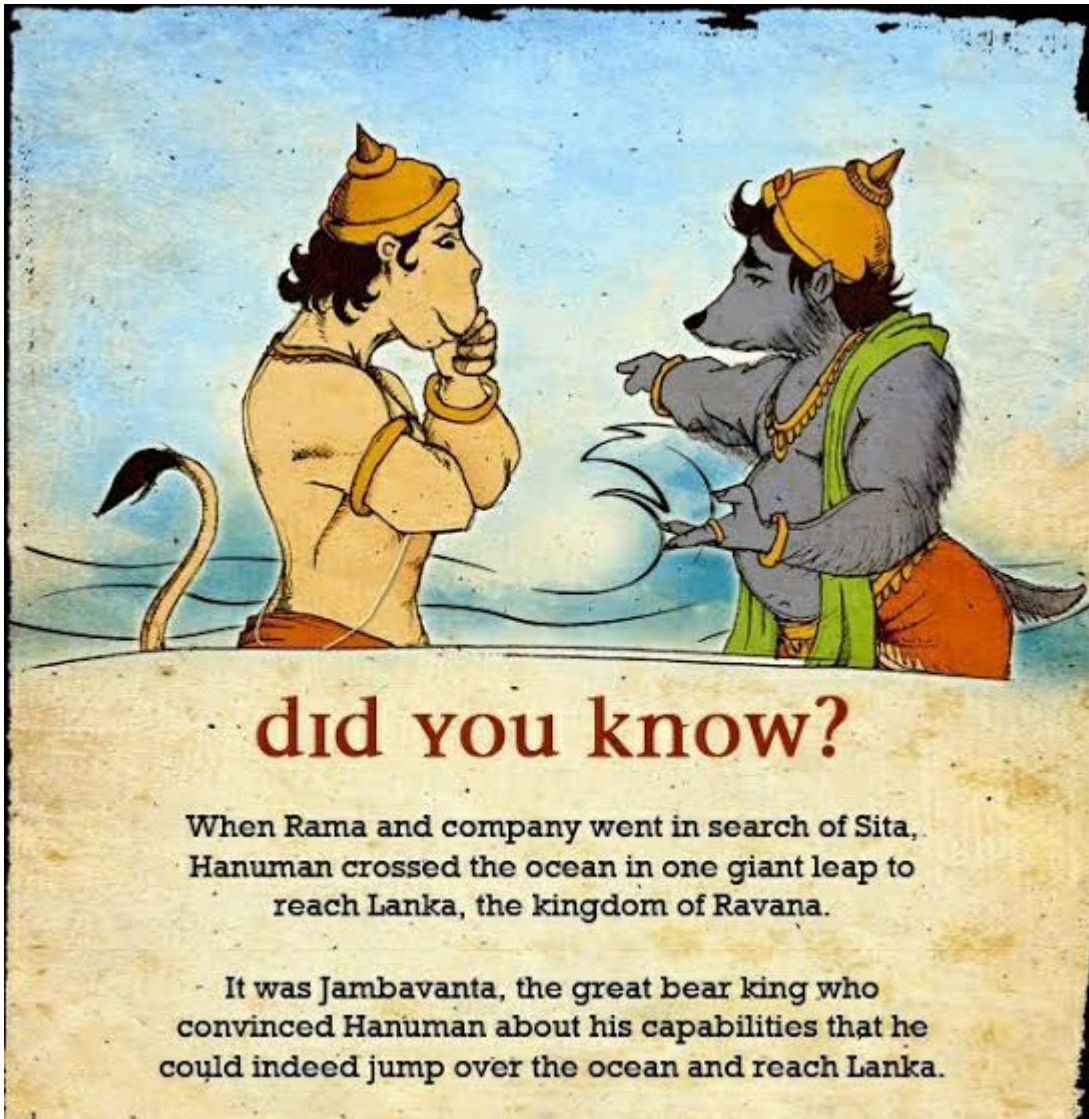
Not only that when Dadimukha tried to prevent them, they all attacked him and other guards.
