Mount Kailash is located in western Tibet.

At an elevation of 6,656 meters above sea level, Mt.Kailash is not a high mountain Tibet.

However, no one has climbed to the Mount Kailash summit.

Kailash Parvat is considered the axis of the universe, the center of the world.

As you can see from Google Maps, the distance from Stonehenge in the UK to Kailash is 6,666 km, which is also the distance from Kailash Range to the North Pole.

The distance from Mt Kailash to the South Pole is 13,332 km, which is exactly twice the distance to the North Pole.

Two beautiful lakes, namely Mansarovar and Rakshas Tal, are located at the base of Mount Kailash.

Of the two, Mansarovar, which lies at an altitude of 14, 950 ft, is considered the highest freshwater body in the world.

Viewing from the south of the ridge, you can see the Kailash Parvat's Hindu OM(■) symbol.

The huge ice trough and horizontal rock formations from the top of the mountain constitute this symbol.
