**THE ONLY TIME WHEN DURYODHAN AND DUSHASAN HELPED YUDHISHTIR I.E
DURING RAJSUYA YAGYA / ARRANGEMENTS OF RAJSUYA YAGYA!!**

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More or less after Yudhishtir's supremacy was established in all the four directions, now was the time to arrange Rajsuya Yagya.



But the ablest of all Yudhishtir first took permission first from Krishna, then his brothers and Sages and later on from the representatives from all over his Kingdom.

After getting approval from all of them, only then did the formal arrangements for Yagya began. Sahdev was asked to arrange all the materials required for the Yagya. Indrasen and Arjun's charioteer Puru were asked to arrange the food grains on large scale and arrange for various varieties of food. Dvaipayana Vyas along with the other Brahmins took the place of Brahma to look after the arrangement of Yagya. Rishi Yagyavalkya would lead the Yagya with Rishi Dhaumya and other Brahmins would be the conductor of Yagya.

The formalities began with arranging a proper place for Yagya. A Puja with chanting of sacred mantras sanctified that place. Sahdev was given the responsibility of inviting all Kings and people's representative.



The Brahmins initiated Yudhishtir formally for the beginning of this Yagya. New houses and Palaces were built to accommodate all the guests.

Nakul was sent to Hastinapur to escort Bhishma, Dronacharya, Dhritarashtra, Duryodhan and others. Kings all-around started assembling there. Prominent amongst them were Subbal, Somadatt, Shalya, Jaidrath, Bhag Dutt. Also the rulers of Keral, Andhra, Kaling, etc were also present. All the Kings where Yudhishtira had established supremacy were present there.

Dushasan was entrusted with proper distribution of food. Over all supervision was given to Bheema and Dronacharya. The one knew the value of received precious stone, Kripacharya was appointed to find the value of gifts and also to distribute it as and when required.



The Yagya was lighted by six types of fires (Arambhaniya, Kshatra, Dhruti, Vyushti, Dwiratra and Dashpeya).

All the assembled were allotted proper and comfortable accommodation. The commoners too got to witness this mega event.
