5. Apar■jayah: becoming unconquerable

6. An■rmi-mattvam: not being bothered by body-generated demands like hunger, thirst, or other fancies

7. D■ra-■rava■a: hearing distant events or things happening

D■ra-dar■anam: seeing far-off activities or occurrences

8. Mana■-javah (manojitva): Physically moving one's body anywhere one desires

9. k■ma-r■pam: acquiring or taking on the desired form

10. Para-k■ya prave■anam (vikranabhav): Taking over another person's body (spirits are thought to take over a person's body if their astral body is weak, but the ability described here is different and superior)

11. Sva-chanda m■tyuh: to just pass away as one wishes (like that of Bhishma from Mahabharat, like that of many sages who left their bodies by their own wish)
