6. In Feb 2015 Kejriwal formed the government and also created a think tank Delhi Dialogue Commission (DDC) to create a policy for Delhi and to run the Delhi government on their advice and plan.

History

The present Government of NCT of Delhi came to power in February 2015 on the basis of a manifesto crafted through an extensive series of 'Delhi Dialogues' with all sections of society. With an innate belief that the process of dialogue should be carried forth even after the formation of government, the Aam Aadmi Party-led Delhi Government constituted the Delhi Dialogue Commission vide its Cabinet Decision no. 2131 dated 27th February 2015.

The Commission was formed with the aim of providing a unique model of collaborative and inclusive development in Delhi. It was set up to bridge the knowledge and capacity deficit in the government, and to take advantage of the vast pool of domain expertise that lies outside the government. The Commission was tasked with the role of considering ideas, identifying the best practices and policies from around the world, and translating these into concrete recommendations to the Government of NCT of Delhi.

Since its formation, the Commission has submitted a number of policy reports and recommendations to the Government of NCT of Delhi on a wide array of development issues. These issues include an infant health insurance scheme, establishment of a Health Care Corporation in Delhi, Delhi Solar Policy, leveraging technology for dengue vector surveillance, piloting of battery electric buses etc.

Subsequently, in addendum to Cabinet Decision no. 2294 dated 24.02.2016, the Council of Ministers of Government of NCT of Delhi modified the terms of reference and the terms and conditions of the Commission vide its decision no. 2945 dated 02.03.2021. The same was notified in the Delhi Gazette on 03.03.2022, effectively restructuring and strengthening the capacity of DDC Delhi.

7. In 2016 Jasmine Shah joined AAP and immediately he was appointed as an adviser to DY CM Sisodia. Jasmine Shah was working with Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab (J-PAL) before joining AAP. As I said earlier J-PAL is founded by Ford Foundation professor Abhijit Banerjee.

Partnership with J-PAL

DDC Delhi has partnered with the Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab (J-PAL) South Asia to strengthen evidence-based policy making in order to stimulate Delhi's social and economic development and achieve the Kejriwal Government's ambitious vision of Delhi@2047. The partnership is aimed at systematically leveraging high-quality administrative data to design, test and scale-up policy solutions in key economic sectors for maximum impact.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the Dialogue and Development Commission (DDC) of Delhi and J-PAL South Asia on 25th February 2022 in the presence of Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Delhi, Shri Manish Sisodia and DDC Vice-Chairperson Shri Jasmine Shah. This partnership was initiated by the IDEA Lab at J-PAL South Asia, part of J-PAL's Innovations in Data and Experiments for Action (IDEA) Initiative.

Features of the Initiative

As the first steps, Delhi Government will explore optimal ways to improve employment outcomes for young workers in Delhi by overhauling the services offered by 'Rozgar Bazaar', the government's flagship job portal. The partnership will find better solutions to match job seekers with appropriate jobs and provide career counselling services on the portal.

The partnership will also contribute data-based insights for Delhi's economic policy, especially in key sectors such as Small and Medium Enterprises, by drawing upon the findings from the research done by J-PAL's global network of the world's leading economists.

J-PAL South Asia, under the guidance of DDC Delhi, will work closely with the health and education departments to evaluate ways to increase child immunisation rates and reduce learning deficits and school dropouts in the aftermath of the pandemic.

Moreover, the policy-research organisation will work to strengthen the culture of evidence-based policymaking within Delhi Government by organising courses for officials on data collection and survey design as well as on randomised evaluations.
