7/ If Mueller can lead a 40-person team of the nation's top attorneys and investigators for dozens of hours every week for 18 months on the most complex federal criminal investigation of our lifetimes, I think we can all sit up from our fainting couches and show some *gratitude*.

8/ *Every single report* saying this investigation would end long ago, and end without indictments, and end without prison sentences—or end with a very small number of each of these—has been proven wrong. And not just wrong: politically motivated. Meanwhile, Mueller is *working*.

9/ Neither I nor anyone else has special insight into the inner workings of Mueller's team or investigation. But we can judge from its HISTORIC ACHIEVEMENTS in calling top political aides and officials to account—and we can judge from history just how early we are in the process.

10/ When you've got Roger Stone saying he'll be indicted; when you have media saying Mueller has evidence Erik Prince perjured himself; when you have TRUMP'S LEGAL TEAM saying collusion indictments WILL come; it's time to STOP spreading fear and doubt about Mueller's work. /end
