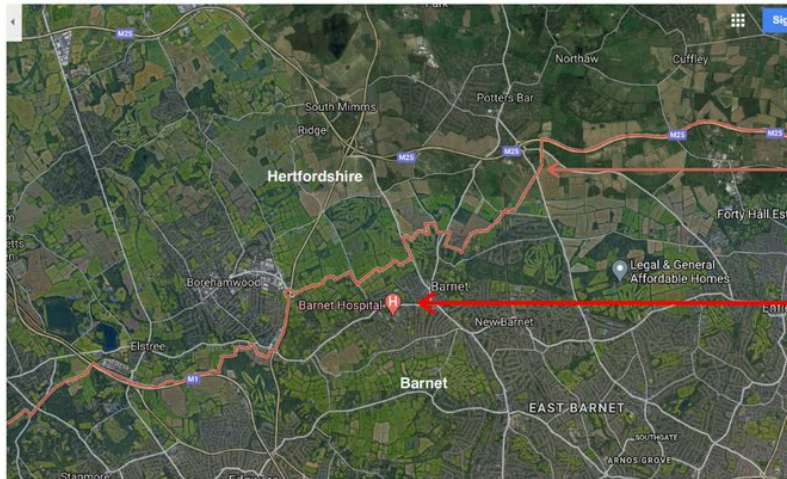
On to the Issues.

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Issue No. 3:

Barnet Hospital is seeing incredible pressures, the trust (The Royal Free Trust) has cancelled most non-urgent and routine work,

and as of 23rd Dec had admitted 244 patients with COVID, roughly half the peak of March, and climbing v. fast.

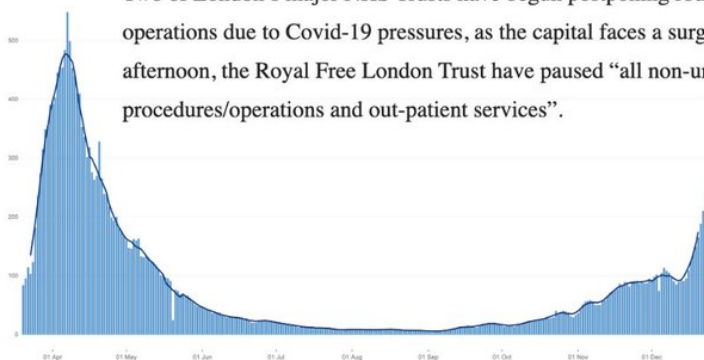


ISSUE NUMBER 3:

BARNET HOSPITAL IS VERY BUSY

London NHS Trust Hospitals Begin Postponing Non-Urgent Care And Operations Due to Covid-19 Pressures.

Two of London's major NHS Trusts have begun postponing routine care and non-urgent operations due to Covid-19 pressures, as the capital faces a surge in cases. From Monday afternoon, the Royal Free London Trust have paused "all non-urgent, time-critical planned procedures/operations and out-patient services".



The trust (the whole organisation) has cancelled a lot of non-urgent appointments and operations.

...and the trust currently has 244 patients admitted with COVID, around half the peak of the first wave and climbing fast.

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Issue No. 4

Even busier is Intensive Care - the whole trust only has 57 beds (23 - Barnet & 34 at the Royal Free Hospital).

As of 23rd Dec, 40 of them were occupied by COVID patients. That's 70% of the ENTIRE CAPACITY used up by COVID ALONE.

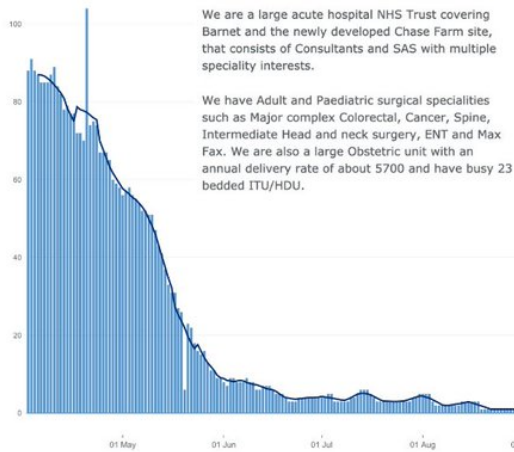

BARNET ICU IS VERY BUSY

Barnet and Chase Farm Hospitals



Intensive care at the Royal Free Hospital

The ICU (intensive care unit) at the Royal Free Hospital comprises 34 intensive care beds. The ICU beds are located in the three intensive therapy wards.

THERE ARE ONLY 57 USUAL ICU BEDS ACROSS THE TRUST (23 + 34)

AND 40 OF THEM WERE OCCUPIED BY COVID PATIENTS ON 23RD DEC 2020, AND RISING.

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Why is this a problem?

For every COVID patient in an ICU bed, another patient isn't - ICU takes routine complex operations, unwell ward patients, other emergencies and even transfers from other hospitals.

We can cancel operations, but can't stop the other unexpected patients.

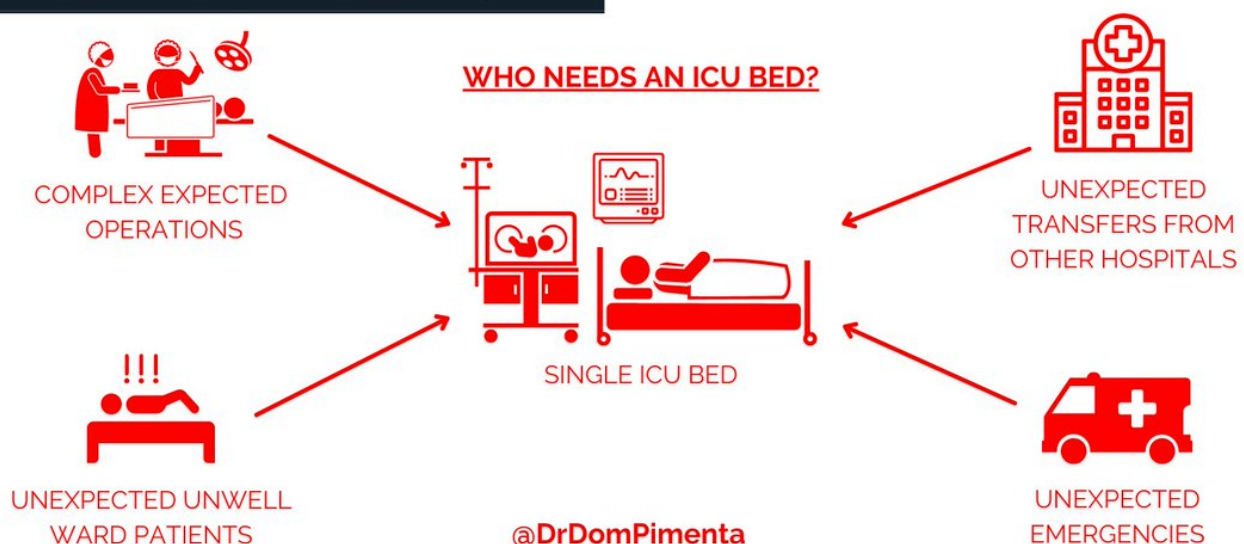
