

ANCIENT WEAPONS USED IN WARS





- 1. Shakti is heavy and long about a metre blue in colour with face like lion. It's sharp tongue is used to strike.
- 2. Tomar is made of iron and wood with lower portion having feathers so that it can fly easily.
- 3. Paash is made of fine wires of metal. Sometimes it is also made of leather. There are two types simple and varun.
- 4. Rushti is a simple weapon something like sword.
- 5. Mace is long at one end and the other end is wider and heavy. Its length is from feet to chest.
- 6. Mudgar is raised by one hand like a hammer.
- 7. Chakra is thrown from far.
- 8. Vajra, Kulish and Ashni are crooked in the upper three portions, middle portion is thin but hands are heavy.
- 9. Trishul has three heads and two teeth.
- 10. Shool is very deadly sharp at one end.

- 12. Khadag is a weapon of sacrifice in the hands of Chandi.
- 13. Chandrahaas is a crooked sword.
- 14. Farsa is like Kulhadi. This is a war weapon.
- 15. Mushal is like mace and can be thrown up to long distance.
- 16. Dhanush is used to shoot an arrow.
- 17. Baan or arrow is of many types mainly sayak, shar arrow.
- Parigh is an iron rod with sharp edge.
- 19. Bhindipal is made of iron and sometimes used to shoot an arrow.
- 20. Narach is a type of arrow.
- 21. Parshu is more like a knife. Parshuram used this extensively.
- 22. Kunta is about five metres upper portion resembling a plough.
- 23. Shanku barchi is a spear.
- 24. Pattish is an axe.
