The pampa sarovar where maa parvati is believed to mediate for Lord Shiva they are said to be married at the Virupaksha temple in Hampi.

Paddy and banana plantations are galore as Brahmaputra flows by

Various carving on Navami dibba, the high seat of King KrishnaDevaRaya during festivals.

You can see various carvings of his wives Chinna devi and Tirumala Devi.

4 different colored stones are used from the four different states won by Devaraya each stone represents a state.

The ruins of the Royal court and palace.

The stone pipelines used by them to divert water were functioning till recently.

The beautiful Tungabhadra with various ruins In it and at its shore

The wells water was used to worship deities.

Mahalakshmi's Yantra was engraved In the stones.

It was buried under sand until recently one wonders how many hundreds of marvels await to be discovered in #Hampi

Communal stone plates for soldiers to eat they sound like metal.

The hazarrama temple called so because it has a thousand carvings depicting various scenes from the Ramayana.

It was built by the king on the occasion of his child's birth.

Only royals were allowed in the temple

Overwhelming to think what it might have been in its full glory.

Ugra and yoga narasimha in one.

Yoga Narasimha, Laxmi Narasimha and Ugra Narasimha all in one moorti damaged by Barbarians

Of course the stone chariot that Devaraya saw in Odisha when we went to war there and came back to Vijayanagara and ordered it to be built here.  
He fell in love with the king's daughter Jaganmohini, who came to kill him n married her

Malyavanta Rahunata temple  
The place where Shri Rama meditated on Lord Shiva during exile, that's exactly the hill under which he meditated  
The place where Laxman hit an arrow to get water for Lord Ram for pooja
