Success stories of girls making 10,000+ monthly are everywhere and many people are amazed that this makes money.

But to me It looks likes amateur hour.

The crazy stories you guys are hearing really are exceptions to the rule.

Take it from me, although 25% of the girls you follow on Instagram now have an onlyfans link posted in their bio, most of them are making nothing.

The vast majority under 100 bucks a month.

Much like the California gold rush, when stories of people striking it rich were everywhere thousands of people headed west with their shovels.

These men had no experience in mining or excavation and came away empty handed.

to a seasoned professional like me? Thats what I see.

For those who don't know who I am, I was at one time the owner of Europes largest cam-girl studio.

Before Onlyfans, before celebrities did it, before it "was cool".

I've done interviews with the BBC, RT news and many others about what I do. This is me-

Before the days of Onlyfans celebrities making the topic mainstream, few people besides myself would speak about this industry.

I would speak out about it because I believe its harmful... TO MEN.

The women? They're largely perfectly happy girls making a great income.

But now that it's gone mainstream I believe it is becoming increasingly harmful to women and I want to explain why.

These are things young girls need to know BEFORE starting up an Onlyfans account.

First and foremost, MOST of you will not make any money.

Most of these "Success" stories are of women who have already made this their career. Sure I have great models at my agency making a tonne with OnlyFans but they have already been online for 5 years on other platforms like livejasmin.

They have fans, social media and reputation.

Girls like this can post onlyfans links and seem like overnight successes, much like a boxer with 200 amateur fights can go pro, score 3 wins by KO and seem like magic.

The work has already been done and it is literally a CAREER for these girls. Onlyfans alone is NOT a career.

If a girl 5 years ago was hired by a professional Cam studio like mine, a bad start online wasn't the worst thing that could happen.

Her team and managers would work on her account, her character and her technique, eventually she would be earning a good salary.

I would advise my models, If you aren't going to do this for years, DONT DO IT.

It takes a very long time to build up your reputation to the point that the life changing money starts pouring in.

All the wonderful girls who worked for me (you know who you are) made it a career.

Every girl under my roof earned personally over 100,000usd per year, with some of my models exceeding 500,000usd.

But there was a price they would pay for their financial success.

They were all fully aware that naked or semi naked photos of them will now exist online.

They bought houses, started businesses, and my retired models were always very happy with the choices made because the financial rewards were REAL.

Which brings me to this "Gold Rush".

Be careful young ladies, you are not a professional and competition in this market is BIG.

Many of you risk photos of you naked floating around for eternity, affecting future relationship and job prospects.

The reward for your sacrifice? You made 200 bucks from your phone for the 45 days you thought you'd "try it out".

The fallout from this will be seen in 2-3 years.

If this line of work is something you wish to do, and to take seriously? I suggest you contact your local webcam studio and ask if they have an onlyfans agency.

If they do? Jump right in and pursue it as a CAREER, reap the rewards for real, its a great business when done right.

As for me? I still run a small studio with some of the elite girls I have hired over the years.

They crush it on Onlyfans as well as their other platforms.

I maintain my small studio of girls and I've since moved on to bigger business ventures.
