The coalition includes groups like Planned Parenthood, Black Lives Matter, the Women's March, Supermajority, Vote Save America, and the Sunrise Movement.

'We can't assume that Donald Trump will respect the peaceful transfer of power,' said group founder Sean Eldridge, adding that if Trump tries to interfere any further, 'then we would mobilize.'

Trump has not yet committed to a peaceful transition of power, and his sudden push for all ballots to be counted by the end of Election Day is his latest effort to engage in voter suppression or intimidation tactics...

..., as well as cast the election as illegitimate before it's even over. It is important to note that 'race calls' from news outlets on Election night are unofficial projections, not confirmed victories or losses. A full count is never completed on Election Day itself.

This year's vote count is expected to take longer than usual, with a record number of voters casting ballots by mail, which take longer to count.

In many key states, mail-in ballots cannot even be opened until Election Day, and legitimately-cast ballots will continue to arrive days later.
